

WELCOME TO THE CAM ACCESS POINT!

HERE'S SOME HELPFUL INFORMATION DURING YOUR VISIT

the CAM can...

- refer you to shelter only if there are availability provided by shelters
- CAM does not manage any shelter facilities and therefore is unable to guarantee shelter openings
- only submit referrals based on the availability that each shelter provides
- explore other options with you if shelter is not available

the CAM cannot...

- override the reported amount of shelter openings provided by shelters
- refer you to shelter if there aren't any openings
- guarantee a shelter bed
- guarantee housing

other helpful information...

- the CAM is the referral process that consumers go through in order to access emergency shelter
- most emergency shelter programs last for up to 90 days
- emergency shelters are meant to provide a safe alternative to being on the streets, in a place not fit for living, or in a dangerous domestic situation
- emergency shelters are not meant to be utilized for consumers who already have a safe place to reside and/or are only in shelter as a means to acquire housing assistance
